Expectations of the School

- Ensure the child's safety and wellbeing is our top priority.
- Ensure a robust and transparent Safeguarding and Behaviour Policy is understood by all stakeholders.
- Ensure our team a positive role models for the children and the school community.
- Nurture and value every pupil as an individual.
- A clear non- gender specific Uniform Policy is provided.
- Ensure the school values underpin our ethos and use the language of 'Ready, Responsible, Resilient and Respectful' in all aspects of school life.
- Establish strong and lasting relationships with our families and provide them with support that goes beyond academic
 education.
- Provide opportunities for parents and children to express views on school issues and have those views listened.
- Challenge and all unauthorised absences and support those with individual circumstances.
- Provide an inspiring and stimulating curriculum that offers equal representation of all subjects.
- Have high expectations of all pupils and give children supportive feedback.
- Inform parents of ways in which they can be involved in their child's education and the school community.
- Inform parents at an early stage of any concerns so that the school and parents can work together.
- Provide parents with a clear travel plan for the school so that a clear parking agreement for the safety of the pupils is established.

Expectations of the Parents

- Ensure the school values are upheld by:
 - **Ready**: teaching your child on how to maintain punctuality and good attendance. This means you will not book term time holidays, your child will be collected from school on time and any reasons for absence will be notified to the school by 9am.
 - Respectful: teaching your child about equality, respecting the environment and others in our community.
 - **Responsible:** role modelling how to be a good citizen, especially in relation to the school community e.g. following the school's parking agreement (see Travel Plan).
 - **Resilient:** allowing your child to make mistakes and giving them the opportunity to respond to challenges independently.
- Ensure you understand and reinforce the school's Safeguarding and Behaviour Policies.
- The Uniform Policy will be strictly adhered to.
- Establish strong and lasting relationships with our school team by maintaining a respectful manner at all times.
- To express your views appropriately towards the school. This means you will not mention or subtly refer to the school on any social media platform in a derogatory light.
- You understand the statutory obligation of the school to challenge all unauthorised absences and will respect the need in some circumstance to further investigate these matters (in alignment with the Attendance Policy).
- Have high expectations in your child engaging with their home learning.
- Be actively involved in your child's education.
- Inform parents at an early stage of any concerns so that the school and parents can work together.

Expectations of the Children

- I will try my best to follow the school values at home and at school:
 - Ready: being on time to school, having excellent attendance and showing outstanding behaviour for learning.
 - **Respectful:** respecting others for who they are regardless of our differences, being kind and helpful towards others and listening to each other and adults.
 - Responsible: being good role models, taking ownership of our learning, looking after our school and demonstrating kindness by helping others to do the same.
 - **Resilient:** taking on challenges by putting in lots of effort, striving to improve and recognising our own and others' achievements, no matter how big or small.
- I will reflect on my behaviour with support from a trusted adult and follow all the school rules.
- I will follow the school's uniform policy and ensure I am dressed in a smart way that reflects the values of our school.
- I will share my thoughts, worries and successes with my friends and teachers. I will tell someone if I am not ok.
- I will only access online platforms with parental permission and guidance. I will tell someone immediately something unsafe has happened online.
- I will come to school every day that I have healthy and capable to do so.
- I will try my best with my home learning and I understand that this will help me to improve.
