<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be a positive role model for children • value every pupil as an individual • provide opportunities for parents and children to express views on school issues and have those views listened to care for each child's safety and happiness • monitor closely all absences authorised and unauthorised • provide a broad and balanced curriculum • have high expectations of all pupils • give children supportive feedback • respond quickly to any concerns, however small • ensure a comprehensive risk assessment is carried out for any school trips or extra-curricular activities • inform parents of ways in which they can be involved in their child's education • hold regular parents evenings to report on progress • inform parents, at an early stage, of any concerns so that the school and parents can work together • have a clearly stated and published Behaviour Policy detailing expectations, rewards and sanctions • encourage high standards of behaviour at all times • display classroom and playground rules • be open and welcoming at all times • offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the daily life of school and in school events • provide remote learning that is accessible to all in the event of school closure; providing quality learning opportunities and feedback from teaching staff on progress. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • support the school's aims and values • send my child to school in good health for the day in accordance with health and sickness regulations • ensure the safety of all children by parking considerately • ensure my child arrives and is collected from school on time • not book holidays in term time without prior consent from the Headteacher • contact school on the first morning of any absence by 9.00am • provide any changes to contact details • ensure my child wears school uniform • let the school know if there are any problems likely to affect my child's learning • encourage my child to always to his/her best • support my child with reading and other home learning activities • acknowledge that this agreement gives consent to my child attending any school trips and/or extra-curricular activities that are provided by the school • attend parents evenings and parent workshops regularly • support the school's behaviour policy • support the school if sanctions become necessary • support outside events in which the school is involved. • ensure that no photos, videos or adverse comments about the children are shared on social media, including; Facebook, Instagram and WhatsApp. • remain respectful and considerate towards all members of the school community. • ensure I have read and agreed the Acceptable Use of Technology Policy • ensure my child has read and understood the Learners Agreement linked to the Acceptable Use of Technology Policy • support their child/ren with remote learning during any periods of class/school closure or self-isolation • ensure all remote learning is undertaken as per the School's recommendation • ensure that they communicate with the School any reason why the remote learning may have not taken place e.g. family are ill with COVID or symptoms. • notify the School if they do not have access to technological devices or wifi in order to access the remote learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • keep our school values and ethos • give my own ideas that will help the school become a better place • work together with my family to help them get me to school on time • work together with my teacher to make sure I leave school on time • help carry what I need at school • look neat and tidy • remember to give my family any letters • remember to bring my book bag every day • not be afraid to make mistakes • ask for help if I need it • listen to my teachers • do my homework, especially 5 minutes of reading every day • help to keep the classroom tidy • always behave in a way that allows everyone to work and play without interrupting them • look after each other • tell a trusted adult if something is making me feel sad or worried • value each other's efforts • understand and follow the Learners Agreement when using technology at school • to let a trusted adult know if I see something online that I do not like • to only use the school computers for safe activities that my teacher has told me to do • complete all remote learning set by the teacher during any periods of self-isolation of class/school closure. • try their very best with all aspects of remote learning.
