Because of the legal requirement to have a maximum of 30 pupils in infant classes, the power of Appeals Panels to allow appeals is very limited, therefore very few are successful.							
Parents are only likely to be successful with an appeal if they can show either:							
 a) That the admission of their child would not breach the infant class size limit b) That a place would have been offered if the admissions arrangements had complied with admissions law or had been correctly and impartially applied. For your appeal to succeed on this ground, you will have to show that the normal admission arrangement as published by the Admission Authority were not properly followed and if they had been, your child would have been offered a place. c) That the decision not to admit their child was not one which a reasonable Admission Authority would make in the circumstances of the case.
